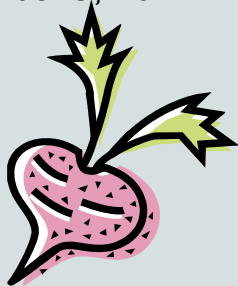


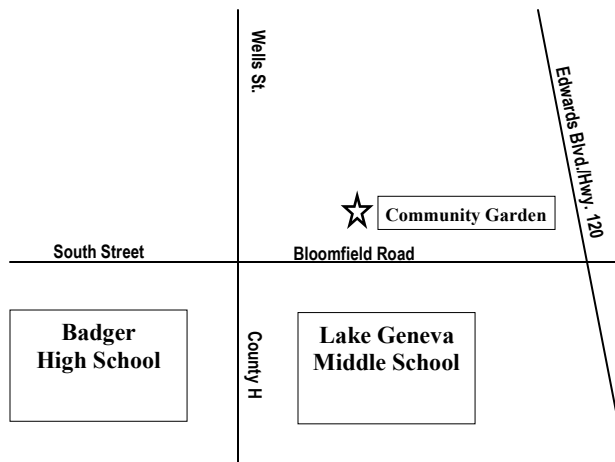
Community gardens provide common ground for people to grow plants, build strong communities, and provide the space needed for a garden. Some benefits of gardening include raising fresh produce, saving money, learning new gardening skills and getting exercise and unwinding.

- Weather permitting, the garden will open on Sat., April 30, 2011.
- Initial rough tilling will be done prior to the growing season.
- Compost bins will be available for disposal of plant waste.
- Water will be available on site.
- The Badger Community Education and University of Wisconsin-Extension staff will offer programs, demonstrations, and updates to support gardeners throughout the growing season.
- Produce must be harvested and plots cleaned by Saturday morning November 5, 2011 (closing date).
